Job Description

Candidate will render professional mental health care and psychological counseling services as may be required for the assessment, evaluation, and treatment of all patients of the Company requiring same in accordance with the prevailing professional standard of care in the community; further responsibilities are as follows

Clinical Services

- Formal and comprehensive evaluations
- Training the therapist in the rationale behind, and administration of, testing instruments that they are permitted to administer to their clients
- Scoring and interpreting therapist administered testing
- Generate results summaries for therapists that can then be used to create, revise, or improve sole treatment plans

Training Services

- Educate and train clinicians to treat specific clinical issues and dynamics
- Work with clinicians during counseling supervision

Qualifications:

Possess a Doctorate Degree in Clinical or Counseling Psychology, or equivalent, from an accredited college approved by the American Psychological Association. Possess a current, valid, unrestricted license to practice Clinical Psychology in any one of the fifty States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam or the U.S. Virgin Islands.
